2024 KINGS ISLAND TRIP

Dear Parents of Fishers Junior High Honor Society Students;

Our trip to Kings Island is scheduled for Tuesday, June 4th. Students should report to the south parking lot at 7:00AM. Buses will leave at 7:15am. We anticipate returning to the school's south parking lot about 10:00pm that evening.

This trip is optional.

The cost of the trip is \$100.00. This includes <u>park admission</u>, <u>FREE drinks wristband</u> and <u>transportation</u> only. Food is not allowed to be taken into the park so your student will need money to eat lunch and supper at the park. <u>The money for the trip is not refundable</u> so be sure your student can go before they commit to this trip. The trip will proceed regardless of the weather.

The trip will be chaperoned by teachers. If your student has medication, it must be given to the chaperone on that bus. There is a clinic at Kings Island where medication requiring refrigeration may be kept.

Students are expected to remain with their group all day and never be alone. This is a school sponsored trip and the school behavior and dress code is expected to be followed. Students are welcome to bring cell phones, but THEY are RESPONSIBLE for them if they are lost on a ride. Any personal items can be placed in a rented locker at the park. Please do not bring anything of great value. The chaperones and the school are NOT responsible for these items.

Students will check in with their chaperone at 1:30 mid-day at the Carousel food court. No exceptions.

Kings Island has recently gone CASHLESS. Students will either need to bring a card they can use, or they can purchase a "Kings Island debit card" while they are on the premises. We just wanted to make sure parents were aware of this prior to the trip.

Signed permission slips along with check or money order made out to Fishers Junior High need to be returned together by Monday, May 6th, 2024. Again, this is not refundable. And we are limited to the first 40 kids to turn in permission slips due to spacing on the bus.
